Persistence: The quality of being steadfast, determined, stubborn, or insistent.
Theme: The central message of a literary work; an idea developed in a text that conveys a message or truth about life and the human experience.
Castle in the air: A fanciful wish or scheme; daydream
External Conflict: A struggle between a character and an outside force, such as another character, a group, or something in nature.
Internal conflict: A struggle that takes place inside a character's mind.
Conspicuous: Easily seen or noticeable
Ferocious: Terrifyingly fierce and scary
Insincere: Phony or fake
Gelatinous: Like a jelly in terms of thickness or firmness
Trivia: Not valuable or important, insignificant
