Mr. Finney has been a National Board-Certified Educator for 18 years and has been selected teacher of the year at both Forest Park and Mann Magnet Middle School. He won the Bessie Moore Award for excellence in teaching economics, and in 2022 received the Gifted Educator Recognition Award for the state of Arkansas. This year, he was one of fifteen teachers nationwide selected as an educator-in-residence at the Henry Ford Museum in Dearborn, Michigan.
