Several of the items listed below such as paper, pens, and pencils are used in all the classes and there is no need to purchase separate items for each class. Teachers may have specific supplies needed for their class which they will tell students on the first or second day of class. 8th grade students will receive their lockers on the 1st or 2nd day of school.

- Wide-ruled loose leaf notebook paper (3 or 4 packages)
- #2 pencils (10+)
- Mechanical pencils for Math & Science
- Pens blue and black ink (all classes) and one red pen (math)
- At least one set of color pencils (box of 12)
- A small hand held pencil sharpener with a cover
- Pocket and prong folder or 3-ring binder sections for various classes
- 3-ring binder/notebook (1 inch) for Science & Foreign Language
- 3-ring binder/notebook for English (1½ inch)
- Index/page dividers (at least 2 sets)
- TI-84+ Graphing calculator (optional for Algebra 1)
- Mesh/Clear backpack only type allowed
- 2 or 4 GB flash drive (for research and other projects)
- 4 Packages of notecards (3 X 5) (English & History)
- Glue stick (a least 1 for use in several classes)
- 2 Spiral notebooks
- 2 large boxes of Kleenex tissue*
- 2 rolls of paper towel*

Most of the items on this list are generic and will be used during the year. For the **first day of school**, students should bring something to write with and write on.
