III. SCHOOL SERVICES

A. The Leader in Me – Chicot Elementary School

The Leader in Me is a program based on providing opportunities for students to develop leadership and life skills by transforming the culture of students in their school and home environments. A team from Chicot visited an elementary school in Bentonville to witness the benefits of implementation.

Chicot students face challenging environmental and demographic issues that have a negative impact on achievement. The Leader in Me provides training for teachers who will then build leadership skills in students to benefit them both academically and behaviorally.

Total cost for the three year implementation is \$73,404.83. The project will be initially funded through the school's Title 1 budget and 1003a funds. Year 1 will be supplemented by NSLA funds and the office of Elementary Education.

The proposal was **approved** as submitted.

VI. FINANCE & SUPPORT SERVICES

A. Energy Leadership Contract
