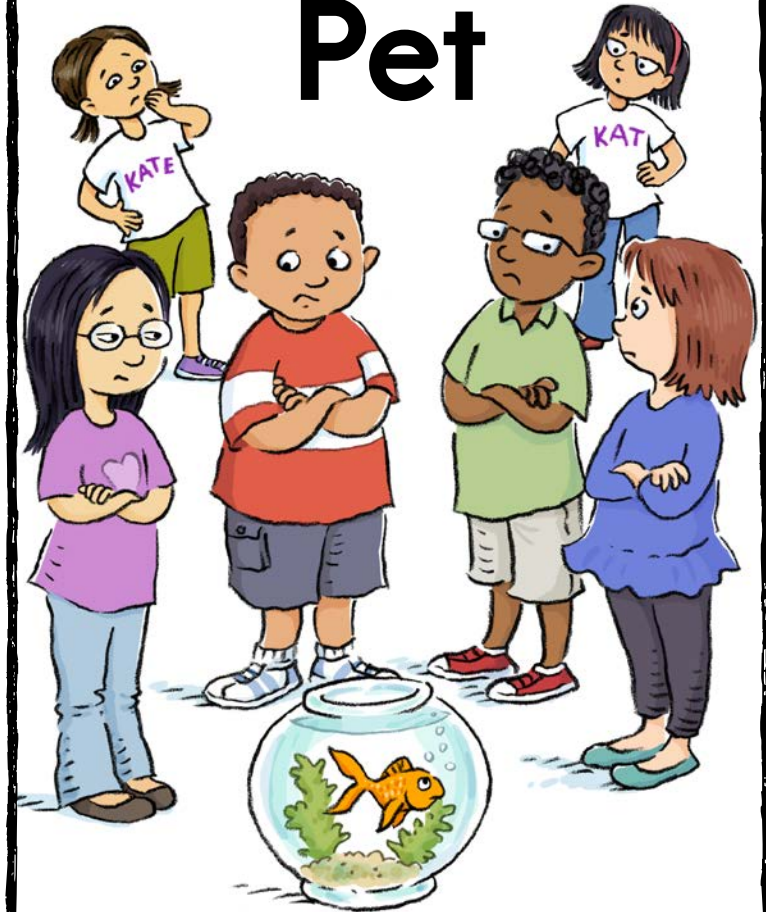

“I’ll feed Fred,” said Matt.



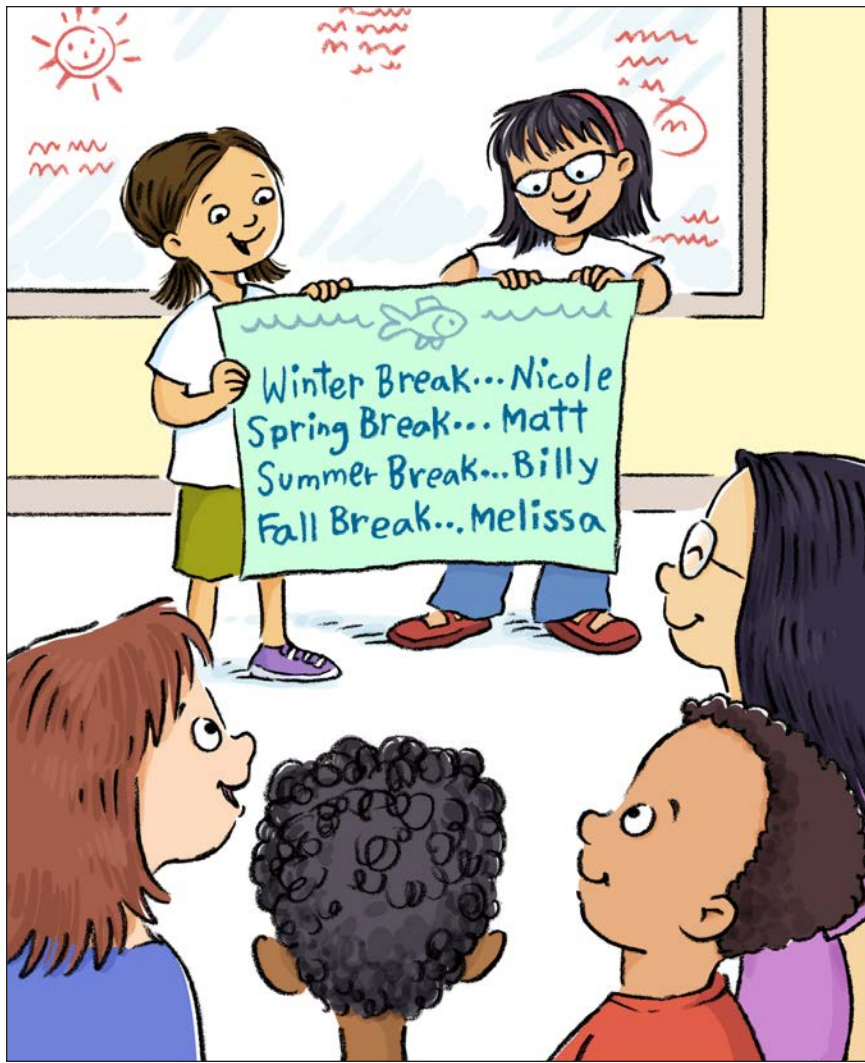
Billy wanted to help.
